

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENT
TO ADAMS COUNTY LAND USE ORDINANCE**

NOTICE is hereby given that a meeting of the Adams County Plan Commission will be held on the 15th day of February, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Commissioners Room (Room 100) of the Adams County Annex, 313 West Jefferson Street, Decatur, Indiana, for consideration of proposed changes to the "Adams County, Indiana Land Use Ordinance of 2005", which Land Use Ordinance was passed and enacted by the Adams County, Indiana Board of Commissioners on March 14, 2005. At the meeting there will be a public hearing and an opportunity for comments from the public. If the Adams County Plan Commission votes to approve amendment(s) to the Land Use Ordinance, a recommendation from the Plan Commission will be made to the Adams County Board of Commissioners. The proposed changes to the Land Use Ordinance will be to the following specific sections of the ordinance:

ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 1, PARAGRAPH "QQ" regarding definition of a Kennel.

ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 3, PARAGRAPH "C(1)" regarding permitted location of a Kennel in a county area zoned "A" or "F".

ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 10, SECTION 3, PARAGRAPH "B(1)" regarding permitted location of a Kennel in a county area zoned "I-1"

ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 17 regarding the creation of procedures and requirements in the ordinance for operating a commercial dog breeding facility. The procedures and requirements for commercial dog breeding facilities shall include, but are not limited to,

- a. DEFINITIONS
- b. REGISTRATION AND FEES
- c. FACILITY AND OPERATING STANDARDS
- d. ANIMAL HEALTH AND HUSBANDRY STANDARDS
