At said time and place the Commission will hear the following: (1) An Application for Approval of County Confined Feeding Operation #389, filed by William D. Girod at 8520 S 200 E., Geneva, Indiana. Mr. Girod would like to construct a 31' x 172' livestock hog barn. The land is described as follows: North Half of the North Half of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter in Section 14 of Wabash Township, Adams County, Indiana, containing 20 acres, more or less, subject to all rights-of-way and legal easements of record. (2) An Application for Approval of County Feeding Operation #390 filed by Stan Becher at 1352 W 350 S, Berne, Indiana. Mr. Becher would like to construct two livestock duck barns, each sized 50' x 292'. The land is described as follows: North Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20 of Monroe Township, Adams County, Indiana, containing 19.36 acres, more or less, subject to all rights-of-way and legal easements of record. (3) An Application for Approval of County Feeding Operation #391 filed by David D. Girod at 2228 E 1000 S, Geneva, Indiana. Mr. Girod would like to construct a 31' x 172' livestock hog barn. The land is described as follows: Northwest Quarter of the Mid Part of the 520.77' Part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 25 of Wabash Township, Adams County, Indiana, containing 15.0 acres, more or less, subject to all rights-of-way and legal easements of record.
