

**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF HEARING ON
PROPOSED CUMULATIVE FIRE FUND**

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of Geneva Town, Adams County, Indiana that the Council will consider at 411 E. Line St. Geneva at 6:30 PM on March 13, 2018 the reestablishment of a Cumulative Fire Fund under the provisions of Indiana Code under the provisions of Indiana Code 36-8-14 for the purposes as follows:

Fire Protection Expense - For all uses as described in IC 36-8-14

The tax will be levied on all taxable real and personal property within the taxing district and will not exceed \$ 0.0333 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The proposed fund will be levied beginning with taxes due and payable in the year 2019. Taxpayers appearing at such hearing shall have the right to be heard thereon. The proposal for reestablishment of the Cumulative FIRE Fund is subject to approval by the Department of Local Government Finance.

Within 30 days after the date of the adoption of the cumulative fund by the Council, the Geneva Town will publish a Notice of Adoption. Upon publication of the Notice of Adoption, 10 or more taxpayers in the taxing district may file a petition with the County Auditor not later than noon 30 days after the publication of the Notice of Adoption setting forth their objections to the proposed fund.
