

Public Notice

Adams County Board of Commissioners, City of Decatur, Adams County, Indiana, in conjunction with Indiana Department of Homeland Security, has applied for Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for Adams County FY2021 Flood Mitigation Acquisition Project. The objective of HMA programs is to fund mitigation measures that reduce the risk of loss of life and property from future hazard events or disasters. Adams County FY2021 Flood Mitigation Acquisition Project is located southwest of Decatur, Indiana in the Special Flood Hazard Area of Borum Run, and involves the acquisition and demolition of a single-family residence prone to repeated flooding.

Under the National Environmental Policy Act, EO 11988 and EO 11990, public notice is required of any federal actions that may affect floodplains or wetlands. Under the National Historic Preservation Act, public notice is also required for some projects which have the potential to affect historic properties. All necessary permits and approvals will be obtained prior to construction and completion of the project.
