The project consists of: **Construction of a detention pond and re-routing an existing sanitary sewer network.**

The City of Decatur reserves the right to reject each and every bid and to waive any or all informalities and errors in the bidding to the extent permitted by law if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the agency to do so. No bidder may withdraw their bid within 60 days after the date for the opening thereof. Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders.
