Notice is hereby given that the Adams County Plan Commission will hold a public hearing on March 21, 2019 at 7:00 P.M. in the Council/Commissioner's Room 100A, 4th Street entrance on the 1st floor of the Service Complex, at 313 W. Jefferson St., Decatur.

At said time and place the Commission will hear the following: (1) An application for approval to expand County Confined Feeding Operation #2 filed by Berne Hi-Way Hatchery at 127 E 800 S, Geneva. They are proposing to build a pullet barn and a layer barn. The land is located in the southwest quarter of Section 10 of Wabash Township containing 34.79 acres more or less. (2) An application for approval for a County Confined Feeding Operation #401 filed by Noah L Schwartz at 2005 E 1100 S, Geneva. Mr. Schwartz is proposing to house 180 head of calves in a 38' x 148' barn. The land is located in the southwest quarter of Section 25 of Wabash Township containing 20.827 acres more or less. (3) An application for approval for a Commercial Dog Breeding Facility #1 filed by Enos EJ Schwartz at 4362 E 900 S, Berne. Mr. Schwartz is proposing to breed 40 female dogs. The land is located in the northwest quarter of Section 20 of Jefferson Township containing 6.0 acres more or less. (4) An application for approval for a Commercial Dog Breeding Facility #2 filed by Danny T Schwartz at 5645 S Salem Rd, Berne. Mr. Schwartz is proposing to breed 17 female dogs. The land is located in the southwest quarter of Section 32 of Blue Creek Township containing 26.326 acres more or less. (5) An application for approval for a Commercial Dog Breeding Facility #3 filed by Sam Kaehr at 1415 S 500 W-1, Bluffton. Mr. Kaehr is proposing to breed 65 female dogs.
