### Adams Central Community Schools 2018 Annual Performance Review Expenditure Goals

P.L. 191-2006 (HEA 1006) states the following: "Beginning with the 2007-2008 school year, each governing body shall establish goals for each category of expenditures set forth in section 4 of this chapter that will increase the school corporation's allocation of taxpayer resources directly to student instruction and learning, in light of the unique circumstances present in the school corporation."

#### Adams Central Community School Goals:

##### 1. Student Academic Achievement Expenditures

The Adams Central Board and community agree that the emphasis is on instruction and achievement. The investment in the areas of instruction, including teachers, instructional materials and instructional supervision will be maintained at present levels whenever possible.

##### 2. Student Instructional Support Expenditures

The Adams Central Board and community agree that supporting the effort to improve instruction is a priority. The schools will maintain the level of support provided in classrooms, guidance and health whenever possible. The school supports the efforts of increased curriculum development and the support of the executive body and administration activities. The expenditures in this area will be maintained at present levels.

##### 3. Overhead and Operational Expenditures

The Adams Central Board recognizes the importance of maintaining an environment that is conducive to learning. The building needs to be properly maintained, modernized, and secured. The school realizes the escalation of the price of fuel to run buses and school equipment, and to remain updated with technology for students and staff. The goal is to have the increase be less than 5%.

##### 4. Nonoperational Expenditures

The Adams Central Board is sensitive to expenditures in this area. The Board will carefully review needs for school buildings, rebuilding and extensions, and take into consideration student and staff present and future needs. Routine maintenance of existing facilities will continue. The board will consider the appropriate expenditures of the corporation that will impact the CPF and Debt Service Fund. The goal is to maintain the tax rate at or around 1.00.
