

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Berne, Indiana will receive sealed bids at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer until the hour of 8:00 A.M., on August 16, 2017, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following described Street Sweeper:

Unified Bid for one (1) new three wheel mechanical type street sweeper, front wheel steer, single engine, high dump hopper, full hydrostatic drive, 5.6 cubic yard hopper capacity with dual gutter broom system. It shall be the manufacturer's latest model and design.

With Trade-In of the City of Berne 2002 Johnston 3000 series Sweeper (viewed by appointment)

Specifications for said vehicle and equipment are on file at the city municipal building in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Berne, Indiana, 158 W. Franklin Street, Berne, Indiana 46711, and all bids shall be made equaling or exceeding the specifications. The identification of certain kinds of equipment in the specifications is not intended to unduly limit competition, but are intended to be the standard equipment required and bidders shall include sufficient information to justify any substitutions or replacements as to its equaling or exceeding the specifications as to any kinds of equipment listed in the specifications. Bids shall include all costs and expenses of mounting and installation of the dump bed, and specified equipment and accessories onto the truck chassis and all transportation and labor shall be part of the bid. Bidders shall give estimated date of delivery. Bidders shall submit complete information concerning the vehicle and equipment as quoted in their bid as more particularly set out in the specifications. All bids shall be accompanied with a bid bond or certified check in the amount of ten per cent (10%) of the bid. The successful bidder shall furnish a one hundred percent (100%) performance bond within thirty (30) days after award of contract. Bids shall be evaluated on the basis of such factors as reliability, productivity and the cost of maintenance and services. The Common Council of the City of Berne reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
