

ORDINANCE NO. 713

SHORT TITLE: AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY OF BERNE, INDIANA AND AMENDING CHAPTER 73, SCHEDULE IV, OF THE BERNE CITY CODE BY THE DELETION OF A ONE-WAY ALLEY

WHEREAS, the City of Berne has adopted the Berne City Code of Ordinances which includes traffic rules and schedules for the designation of approved traffic patterns, the designation of prohibited parking areas, and the designation of parking spaces for persons with physical disabilities throughout the city; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council believes that it is in the best interest of public safety and for the general welfare for the alley between Lots 182 and 183 in the 20th Addition, being the alley running north and south for a half block from Main Street to the east and west alley between Sprunger Street and Baltimore Street, be listed as a two-way alley as set forth in Chapter 73, Schedule IV of the City Code entitled Traffic Schedules, said direction of said alley to one-way alley to be west.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERNE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

ITEM I

1.1. Title VII, Chapter 73, Schedule IV of the Berne City Code, is hereby amended to delete the one-way alley in the schedule as follows (and for said alley to be a two-way alley):

1.2. Said alley shall no longer be a one-way alley with traffic travelling north, but shall be considered as a regular two-way alley with traffic travelling north and south unless traffic upon said alley is controlled by a police officer on duty, in which event the directions of the police officer shall be complied with.

1.3. The present street sign(s) designating the alley described in Section 1.1 of this Ordinance as a one-way alley traveling north and notifying vehicles thereof shall be removed.

ITEM II

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and due publication.
