

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATION ADVERTISEMENT

CITY OF DECATUR "GUARANTEED SAVINGS CONTRACT"

The City of Decatur, Indiana requests Qualifications for the Water Treatment Improvements Projects, herein referred to as the "PROJECT." The responses to the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) will provide a means by which the City of Decatur will select a single licensed Indiana Provider to complete a Guaranteed Savings Contract. Sealed Qualifications will be received by the City of Decatur, Indiana, herein referred to as "OWNER", at the Decatur City Utilities Office located in City Hall, 172 North Second Street, Decatur, Indiana 46733, on September 21, 2018, until 4pm (local time). Qualifications received later than the above date and time may not be considered. Four (4) complete hard copies and one (1) electronic copy of the Qualifications shall be submitted. The Qualifications shall conform to IC36-1-12.5.

The Owner's objective in issuing the RFQ is to provide a means by which to select a Guaranteed Savings Contract Provider(s), herein referred to as "PROVIDER" to perform the Project, which at the sole discretion of the Owner may apply to multiple phases. The first phase will be the construction of a new ground water treatment plant and associated appurtenances. A second phase is also proposed at a later date consisting of the renovations of the Winchester Street water treatment plant and rehabilitation of the existing raw water main.

RFQ responses may be reviewed to determine completeness prior to further evaluation. Owner may request an oral interview from one or more potential Providers to address specific issues. The interview will allow the potential Providers under consideration to clarify the specific points of their response to the RFQ. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all RFQ responses and to be the sole judge of the value and merit of the RFQ responses offered.
