South Adams's expenditures in fiscal year 2017 were spent on student instructional support, which includes guidance counselor and principals' salaries and benefits, office secretaries, and health services. The state average for the same time period was 9.2%. The schools will strive to maintain the level of support services 3. Overhead and Operational Expenditures The South Adams Board recognizes the importance of maintaining a physical environment that is conducive to learning. The building needs to be maintained, modernized, and secured. According to the State of Indiana Office of

Management and Budget, 20.3% of all South Adams's expenditures in fiscal year 2017 were spent on overhead and operational expenses, which includes corporation administration salaries and benefits, operation and maintenance of facilities, security, pupil transportation, food services, and technology. The state average for the same time period was 22.6%. The school realizes the increased cost in heating and cooling, in the price of fuel to run buses and school equipment, and in updating technology infrastructure.
