

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Berne, Indiana will receive sealed bids at the office of the Clerk-Treasurer until the hour of 8:00 A.M., on September 21, 2022, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following described 2024 Sanitation Truck:

Unified Bid for one (1) new 2024 Single Axel 4x2 Heavy Duty Sanitation Truck, to be painted DuPont 94121, Martin Senour 99L 101133, or Akzo Nobel 5382, pursuant to detailed specifications on file with and available from the Office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Berne.

With Trade-In of City of Berne 2006 International Sanitation Truck (viewed by appointment)

Detailed specifications for said vehicle and equipment are on file at the city municipal building in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Berne, Indiana, 158 W. Franklin Street, Berne, Indiana 46711, (260) 589-0081, and all bids shall be made equaling or exceeding the specifications. The identification of certain kinds of equipment in the specifications is not intended to unduly limit competition but are intended to be the standard equipment required, and bidders shall include sufficient information to justify any substitutions or replacements as to its equaling or exceeding the specifications as to any kinds of equipment listed in the specifications. Bids shall include all costs and expenses of mounting and installation of the packer body, and specified equipment and accessories onto the truck chassis, and all transportation and labor shall be part of the bid. Bidders shall give estimated date of delivery. Bidders shall submit complete information concerning the vehicle and equipment as quoted in their bid as more particularly set out in the specifications. All bids shall be accompanied with a bid bond or certified check in the amount of ten per cent (10%) of the bid. The successful bidder shall furnish a one hundred percent (100%) performance bond within thirty (30) days after award of contract. Bids shall be evaluated on the basis of such factors as reliability, productivity and the cost of maintenance and services. The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Berne reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
