NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING Proposed Improvement of SR 124 from US 27 to Keller Street in Adams County

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will host a public information meeting on Tuesday October 4, 2022 at Adams Central Middle School, 222 West Washington Street, Monroe, IN 46772. The doors will be open at 5:00 p.m. to give participants time to view displays and talk to project representatives prior to the start of the meeting. The public meeting presentation will begin at 6:00 p.m.

The purpose of the public meeting is to offer all interested persons an opportunity to comment on current preliminary design plans for a proposed reconstruction project on State Road (SR) 124 between US 27 and Keller Road Monroe, Indiana, Adams County (DES 2001852).

The purpose of the SR 124 project is to improve road condition, address drainage deficiencies, and address local community needs and interests.

The preferred alternative will include full depth pavement replacement on new profile grade and improve the pavement condition. The addition of design elements such as curb and gutter, ditch improvements, and properly sized storm pipe systems, promotes roadway serviceability and motorist safety per INDOT requirements. The 8-foot paved shoulders are wide enough to safety accommodate buggy traffic and will be specifically designed to support long term buggy traffic without forming ruts. The proposed sidewalks will provide improved separation between vehicular and pedestrian traffic and ADA compliant curb ramps will ensure that the facility is accessible to all users.

Proposed construction of the project is anticipated to begin in Spring of 2025 and would be constructed utilizing phased construction.

All written statements submitted prior to, during, and for a period of two (2) weeks following the hearing date, will be evaluated, considered, and addressed in subsequent environmental documentation.
